## MAINTENANCE DREDGING ON THE THAMES

This Notice is also promulgated as Notice to Agents, Berth and Ship Operators 3 of 2014.

As of the 6<sup>th</sup> April 2014, all operators intending to undertake maintenance dredging on the River Thames will require a licence from the Marine Management Organisation (MMO) in addition to the licence that is already granted by the PLA (Port of London Authority).

While dredging was made a licensable activity nationally by the Marine & Coastal Access Act 2009, the MMO only licenced capital dredging while giving transitional period for more regular maintenance activities. This transitional period ceases on the 6<sup>th</sup> April 2014.

These new arrangements do not alter the requirement for all maintenance dredging on the River Thames to be consented by the PLA.
