

NOTICE TO MARINERS L15 of 2017

SEA REACH OIKOS No.1 JETTY FENDER REPAIRS

Mariners are advised that commencing on Monday 31st July fender repair works will commence at the Oikos Storage Jetty No.1 in Sea Reach.

The work will involve a crane barge carrying out the removal and installation of fender elements. The barge will be moored on the front face of the jetty to undertake the programmed 3 to 4 days of works required to change the fender.

The barge will be towed in place by the tug "HORTON" and the safety boat "KGII" will be in attendance throughout the repair works. All vessels will maintain a listening watch on VHF Ch68 while the works are being undertaken and work is expected to be completed by the 6th August.

All vessels are required to be mindful of their wash and the effects of draw-off when passing Oikos Jetty No. 1 during the works, and follow any temporary speed restrictions, as and when advised by London VTS.

Further details of when work is being undertaken, as well as any temporary restrictions to passing traffic will be included on the regular London VTS River broadcast on VHF Channel 68.
