

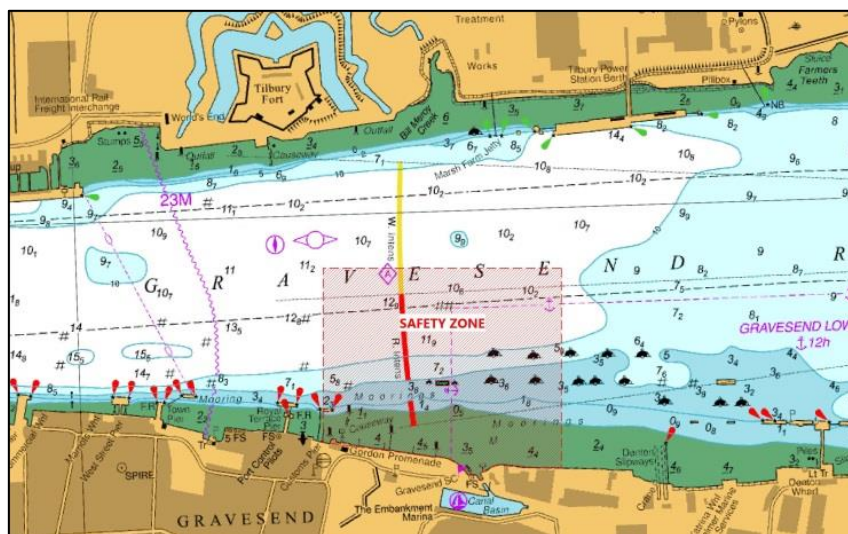
NOTICE TO MARINERS L21 of 2018

GRAVESEND REACH

GRAVESEND FIREWORK DISPLAY

On Friday 2nd November 2018 at 20:00 a fireworks display will take place over the River Thames on the south side of Gravesend Reach.

The display will be conducted from the PLA Salvage vessel LONDON TITAN, which will be position approximately 150m offshore from Gordon Promenade, Gravesend.



A SAFETY ZONE will be in place from 19:45 till 20:45 extending 300m from LONDON TITAN. This area covers any potential fall out from the fireworks. Mariners are asked not to transit this zone during the display and any vessels moored in this zone do so at their own risk. A harbour service launch will be on duty for the purposes of maintaining the safety zone, showing a blue flashing light, with the call sign prefix THAMES PATROL and maintaining a listening watch on VHF Channel 68 throughout.

“London VTS” will co-ordinate commercial traffic movements accordingly along Gravesend Reach in order that they do not coincide with the time of the display

The firework display is expected to last 20 minutes.
