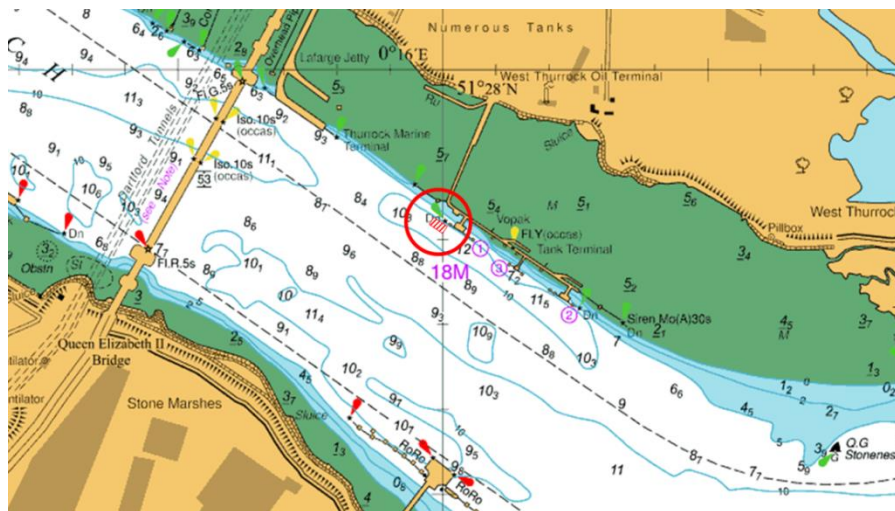


NOTICE TO MARINERS L3 of 2018

LONG REACH NAVIGATOR TERMINAL TEMPORARY REPAIRS TO UPSTREAM DOLPHIN

Mariners are advised that work will start on or around the 17th February 2018 in order to carry out temporary repairs on the upstream dolphin of Berth No. 1 at Navigator Terminal (charted as Vopak).



The work will include the fitting of temporary yokohama fenders onto the upstream dolphin using a crane barge positioned alongside. Additional repairs and alterations will be carried out the walkway and associated metal work. The duration of works are expected to last 48 hours with work continuing throughout the night. All plant will be removed once works are completed.

Works will be carried out with a crawler crane mounted on the Spud-legged flat-top Barge WILLCARRY 1750 and a safety boat will be in attendance at all times. All vessels will maintain a continuous listening watch on VHF Channel 68.

Vessels navigating in the vicinity of the works are to do so with particular caution with due regard of the works taking place. London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in the Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014, as required by the works. International Code flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed when this is in effect.
