

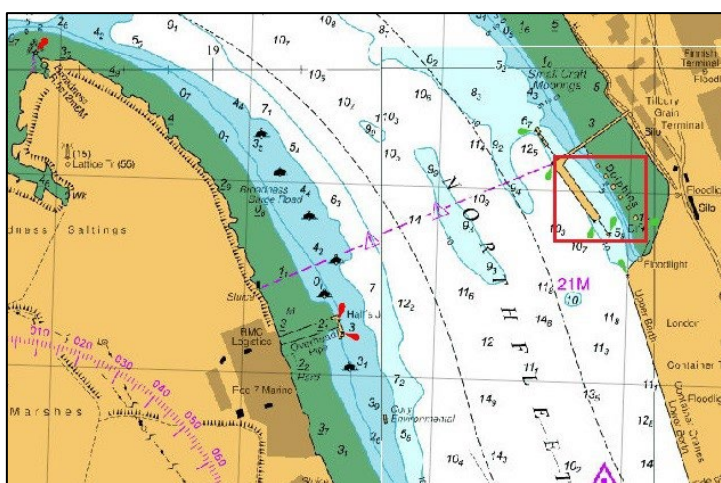
NORTHFLEET HOPE

TILBURY GRAIN TERMINAL

PILE REPLACEMENT WORKS

Mariners are advised that, on or about 20th November 2023, contractors instructed by the Port of Tilbury London Ltd. will commence pile replacement works at Tilbury Grain Terminal Inner Berth.

The location of Tilbury Grain Terminal is indicated by the red markings on the chartlet below:



These works will include use of a crane barge and mobile elevated working platform; a safety boat will be in attendance. Working hours are expected to be 0700 – 1700, Monday to Friday; and the works are planned to be completed within 5 days from commencement.

Requirements to proceed with caution or at slow speed will be made in accordance with the procedures set out in the Port of London Authority’s [Port Information Guide](#), under ‘London VTS’, ‘Section 4’ with the International Code Flags ‘Romeo Yankee’, which are illustrated, displayed.

The display of these signals will be in addition to any lights or shapes required under local regulations and the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea.

Further details will be broadcast as appropriate by **London VTS** on VHF channel **68**.
