

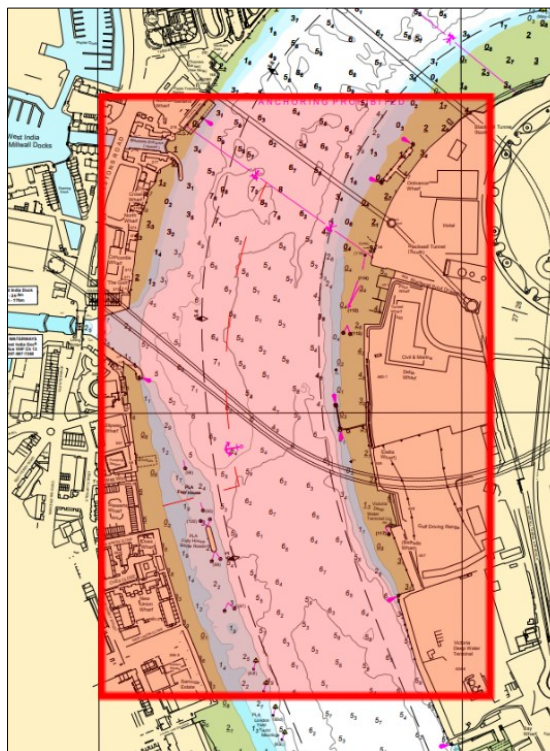

NOTICE TO MARINERS

## BLACKWALL REACH

**M103-23**

On Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> November 2023 and Monday 20<sup>th</sup> November 2023 between the hours of 00:01 and 05:00 an Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) event will be conducted in Blackwall Reach. To support these operations, an exclusion zone will be established between Northumberland Wharf and London Yard.



When the exclusion zone is established, Port of London Authority (PLA) Harbour Service Launches, will be in attendance displaying flashing blue lights to provide Local Traffic Control as required. Mariners may experience delays to their passage of no more than 15-minutes and the PLA will endeavour to ensure disruption to port operations are kept to a minimum.

Owners and operators are reminded that no manned vessels other than emergency service vessels responding to an incident and vessels engaged in operations are permitted within the exclusion zone.

All vessels are to maintain a continuous watch on VHF Channel 14, following instructions from the attending Harbour Service Launches exhibiting flashing blue lights; call sign prefix 'THAMES PATROL'. Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
