

## NOTICE TO MARINERS M103 of 2017

### LAMBETH REACH CHARING CROSS RAIL BRIDGE NO. 1 ARCH CLOSURES

Further to the works described in M69 of 2017.

Mariners are advised that on or about 20<sup>th</sup> November 2017, contractors working on the Tideway Tunnel Project will commence construction of the cofferdam cells nearest Charing Cross Rail Bridge.

Plant and equipment will be in close proximity to the upstream side of No.1 arch requiring closure periods as indicated below:

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012 namely:

- By day, three red discs 0.6 metres in diameter at the points of an equilateral triangle with the apex downwards and the base horizontal
- By night, three red lights in similar positions to the discs displayed by day.
