

NOTICE TO MARINERS M110 of 2017

BATTERSEA REACH FULHAM RAIL BRIDGE SURVEY OPERATIONS

On the 7th, 8th and 13th December 2017 Fulham Rail Bridge inspection surveys will be conducted on behalf of Port of London Authority and Transport for London.

The inspection works will involve survey teams working on the foreshore over low water periods on the following dates:

Date	Start Time	End Time	Navigational Information
Thursday 7 th December 2017	09:00	13:00	Low water foreshore works taking place
Friday 8 th December 2017	10:00	15:00	Low water foreshore works taking place

Further inspection works will be conducted on the central bridge piers around the high water period DRIFTWOOD II and supporting dory will be moored alongside the bridge piers in arches 2 and 4. The central arch will remain navigable and Local Traffic Control will be conducted on the following date:

Date	Start Time	End Time	Navigational Information
Wednesday 13 th December 2017	08:00	12:00	Local Traffic Control with arches 2 and 4 closed to navigation

DRIFTWOOD II will maintain a continuous VHF watch on VHF Channel 14, and display the lights and shapes as prescribed in Rule 27 of the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972 namely:

- By day, three black shapes in a vertical line the highest and lowest of which are balls and the middle one a diamond.

All vessels are to navigate in the area with caution, maintaining a continuous watch on VHF Channel 14. On Wednesday 13th December 2017 vessels are to follow instructions from the attending Harbour Service Launch exhibiting flashing blue lights, call sign prefix 'THAMES PATROL', also on VHF Channel 14.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
