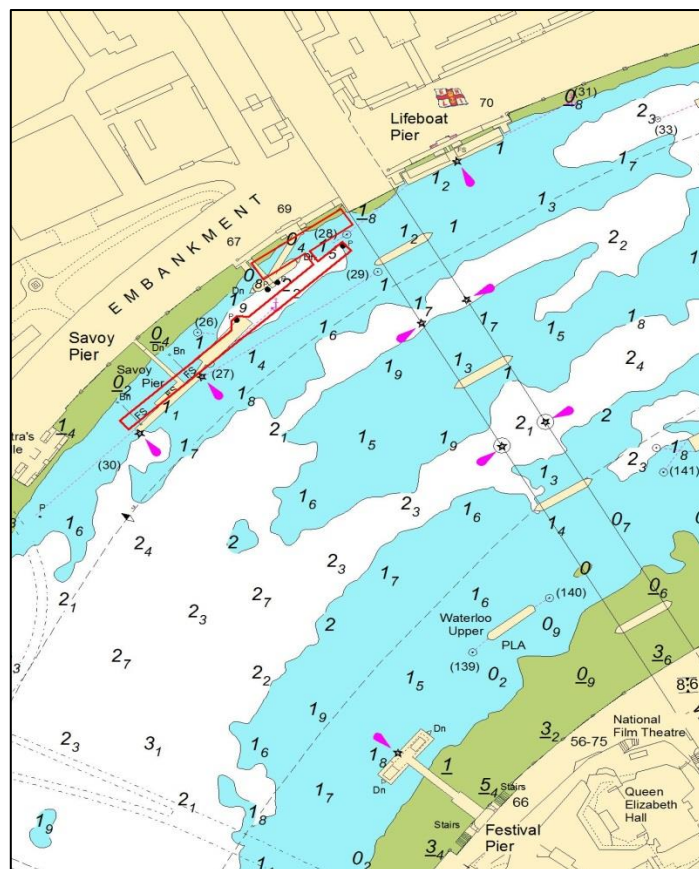


NOTICE TO MARINERS M12 of 2018

KINGS REACH SAVOY PIER PILING, DECONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION WORKS

This Notice supersedes M6 of 2018, which is hereby cancelled.

Contractors working on behalf of Woods River Cruises will be conducting piling operations as well as deconstruction works for the removal of the existing Savoy Pier, remaining Queen Mary moorings and associated structures. This will be followed by the installation of a new pier across both sites, which will be known as Woods Quay (see chartlet below)



The works will commence on or about **Tuesday 6th February 2018**, when the Crane Barge DEVON, supported by a safety boat, will be mobilised to site to begin piling works. The DEVON will initially be located off the remaining Queen Mary moorings before relocating off Savoy Pier. The works are expected to take up to 10 weeks

For the duration of the piling works the number 1 arch at Waterloo Bridge will be closed as follows;

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012 namely:

- By day, three red discs 0.6 metres in diameter at the points of an equilateral triangle with the apex downwards and the base horizontal
- By night, three red lights in similar positions to the discs displayed by day

Vessels navigating in the vicinity of Savoy Pier are to do so with particular caution and due regard to the works taking place. London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in the Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014, as required by the works. International Code flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed when this is in effect.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
