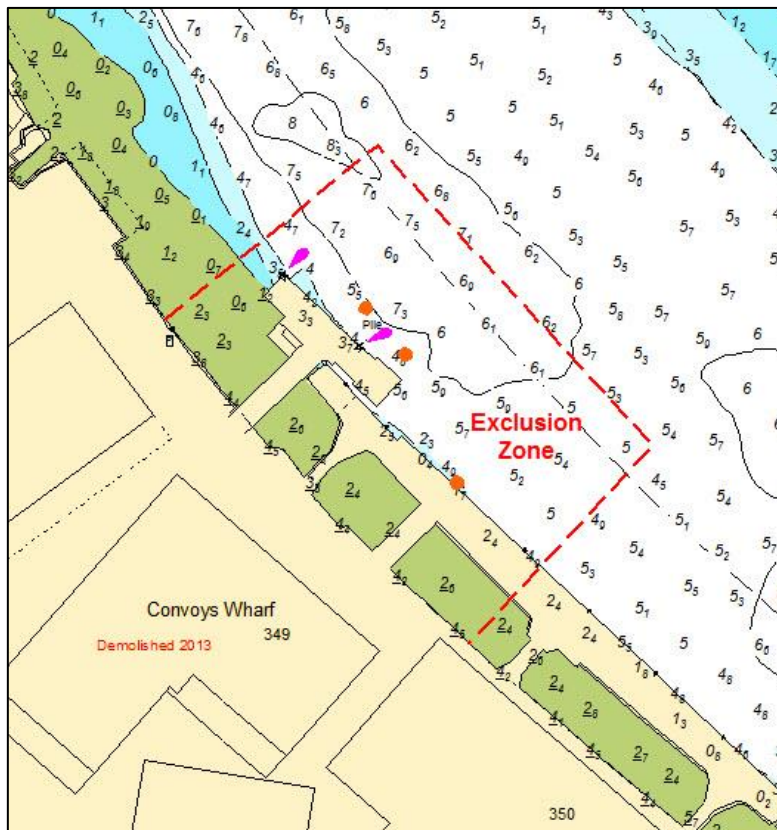


NOTICE TO MARINERS M19 of 2018

GREENWICH REACH CONVOYS WHARF BORE HOLE OPERATIONS

On or about **Wednesday 7th March 2018** contractors will be conducting ground investigation works on behalf of Hutchison Property Group at Convoys Wharf in Greenwich Reach. The works are expected to take approximately four weeks.

The works will be conducted from the jack-up barge **HAVEN SEARISER 2** and consist of 3 individually drilled bore holes in the sited marked on the chartlet below. An exclusion zone will be established extending 50m around the works.



London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014 as required by the works. International Code flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed when this is in effect. All vessels are to navigate in this area with caution, maintaining a continuous watch on VHF Channel 14 and follow the instructions from London VTS.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
