TOWER BRIDGE

ABSEILING OPERATIONS NO.1 ARCH

Contractors working on behalf of the City of London will be conducting abseiling operations to clear oil staining on the northern buttress of Tower Bridge from **Monday 25th January 2021** for approximately one week.

In order to accommodate these works a cradle will be lowered from the balustrade of the bridge on a daily basis, during the hours of 08:00 to 17:00.

Whilst No. 1 arch of Tower Bridge will not be closed to navigation, mariners are advised that "Tiger Stripe" boards will be hung from the balustrades to mark the extremities of the work zone and vessels are requested to navigate clear of this area.

Safety Boat **PRONTO** will be in attendance throughout these operations and will be maintaining a listening watch to VHF Channel 14.

Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on VHF Channel 14.
