

HURLINGHAM & TRINIDAD WHARVES CONSTRUCTION

This notice supersedes Notice to Mariners M59 of 2017.

Mariners are advised that contractors working on the Tideway Tunnel Project will continue works which involve reinforcing sheet piles, fitting out the berths, and the construction of a campshed at Hurlingham and Trinidad Wharves.

Please see the chartlet below depicting the location of the works.



The works will also include dredging, and with the delivery of materials and equipment. During these activities the removal of shaft material by barges will also take place. A variety of vessels including Jackup barges, crane barges, tugs, workboats and Multicat vessels will be used and the works are expected to take approximately 6 months. The vessels involved will maintain a continuous listening watch on VHF channel 14. When required RY flags may be exhibited in conjunction with "proceed with caution / slow down requests" in VTS broadcasts.

No vessels other than those engaged in the works or muckaway shall enter the navigation exclusion zone depicted by the red line on the chartlet.

Vessels are requested to be mindful of the nature of the works, their wash when passing the works and to pass at a safe distance.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
