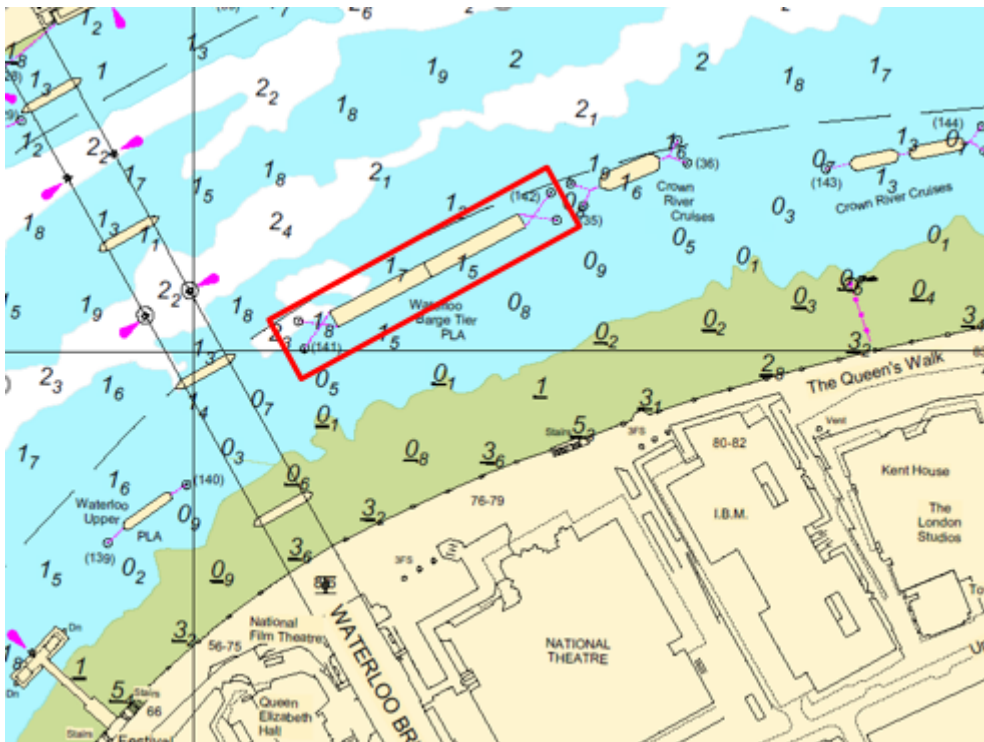


NOTICE TO MARINERS M26 of 2020

KING'S REACH COIN STREET MOORINGS REMOVAL OF WATERLOO BARGE TIER

On or about the 10th August 2020 the Waterloo Barge Tier will be removed for maintenance works. In the absence of the Tier the four mooring legs will be marked with a lit yellow Norfloat buoy with the following flashing characteristic: Fl.Y.3s. The works are expected to take 8 weeks with collar barges being reinstated in early October.



Works to slip the barges from the moorings and to mark the chains will be undertaken by a "PLA DRIFTWOOD" craft. The collar barges will be removed from the site by the tug "DEVOUT" and will be on station throughout the removal of the barges from the tier. All vessels will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 14.

Further information when operations are taking place will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
