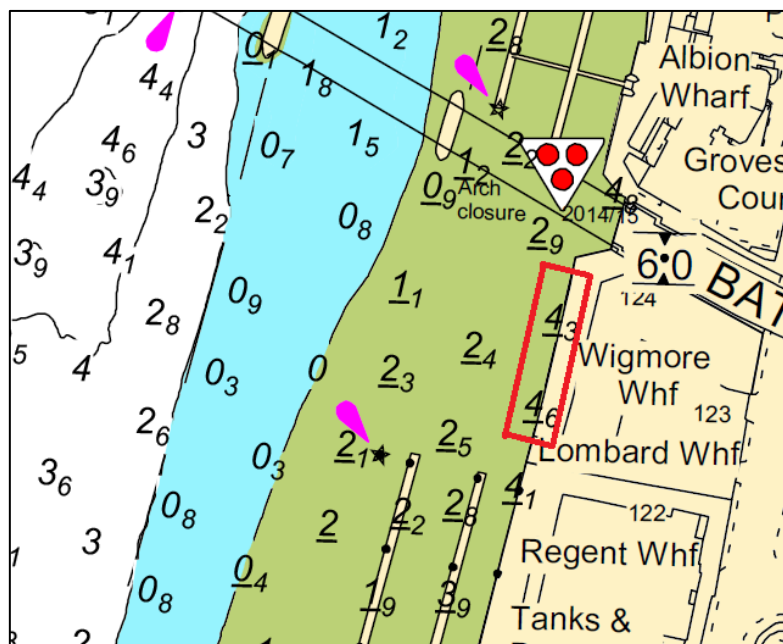


NOTICE TO MARINERS M33 of 2017

WANDSWORTH REACH LOMBARD AND WIGMORE WHARVES RIVER WALL WORKS

Mariners are advised that repair works will be undertaken on the river wall at Lombard Wharf and Wigmore Wharf from 10th April to 15th May 2017. The works will be undertaken from a temporary pontoon close to the river wall as well as works on the foreshore. The dimensions of the pontoon from which the work is to take place from are 3m x 10m.

Please see the chartlet below depicting the location of the works.



Vessels navigating in the vicinity of Lombard Wharf and Wigmore Wharf are to do so with particular caution with due regard of the works taking place. London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in the Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014 as required by the works. International Code flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed when this is in effect.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
