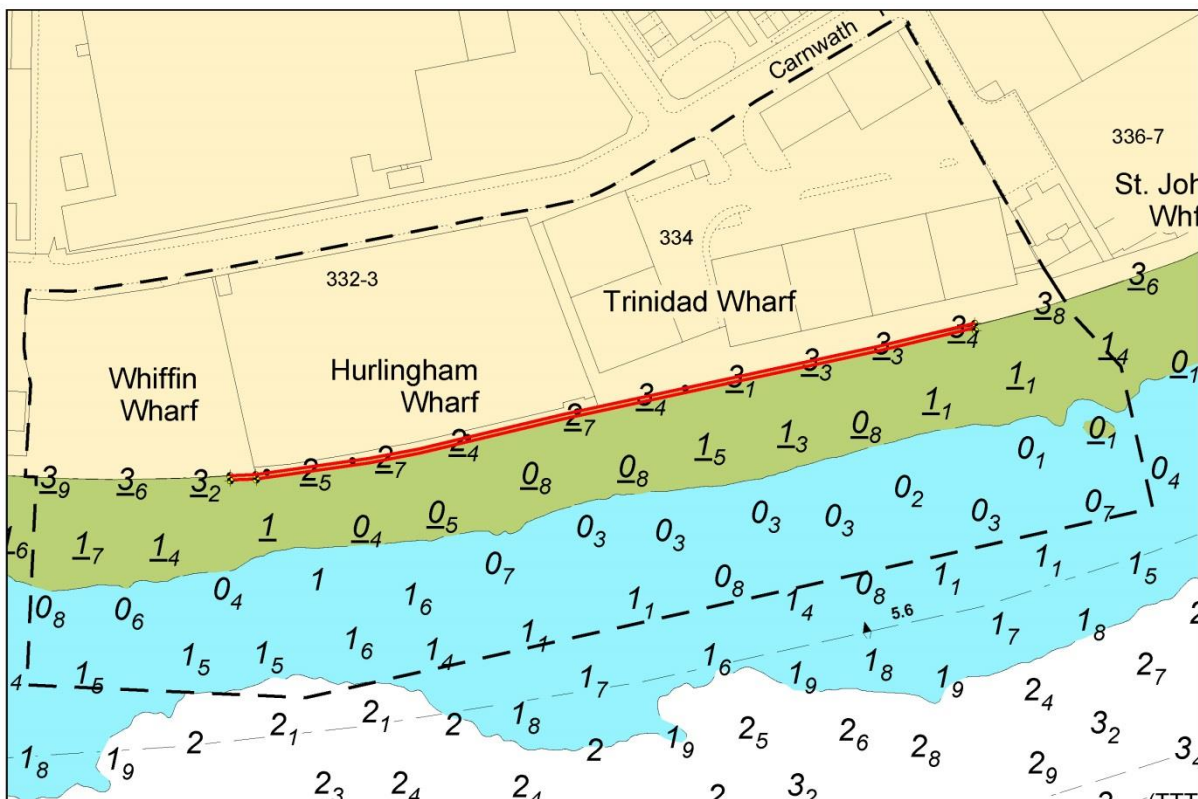


NOTICE TO MARINERS M35 of 2017

WANDSWORTH REACH HURLINGHAM WHARF **RIVER WALL STRENGTHENING**

Mariners are advised that on or about 2nd May 2017 until approximately mid July 2017 contractors working on the Tideway Tunnel Project will place a platform in the position outlined in the chartlet below to conduct strengthening works of the river wall.



Works will be undertaken until the platform is submerged at high tide. To facilitate safe working in this area, a pass with caution will be required approximately 1 hour before until one hour after High Water.

London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014 as required by the works. International Code flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed when this is in effect.

Vessels are requested to be mindful of their wash at all times when passing the works and to pass at a safe distance.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
