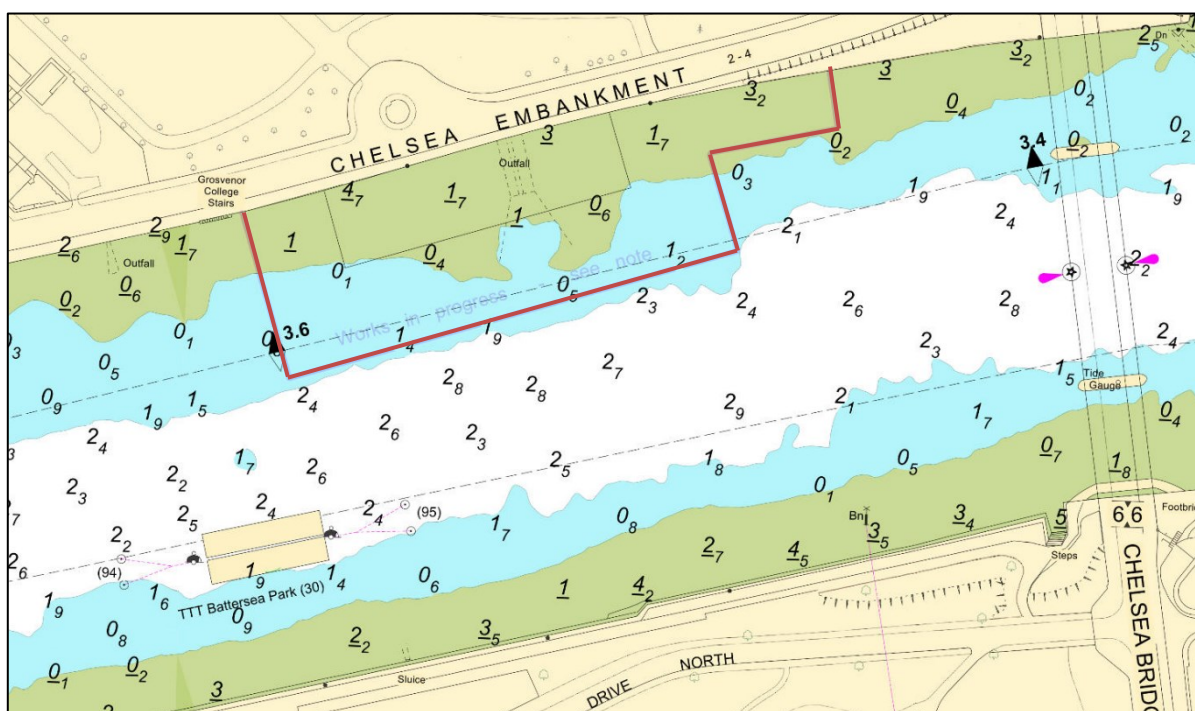


CHELSEA REACH CHELSEA EMBANKMENT DECONSTRUCTION WORKS

Mariners are advised that on or about Friday 31st March 2023, contractors working on the Tideway Tunnel Project will commence works to remove the temporary cofferdam wall at Chelsea Embankment, upriver of Chelsea Bridge. Works will last approximately 12 months.

The area of works is shown on the chartlet below.



Works will involve excavation, pile removal, dredging, diving and laying of scour protection using a variety of crane barges, jack up barges, supply barges, tugs, work boats and multicat vessels. The vessels will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 14.

At times, requests for vessels to proceed with caution or pass at slow speed will be made by London VTS on VHF ch.14, in accordance with the Port of London Authority's [Port Information Guide](#), under 'London VTS', section 4. International Code Flags 'Romeo Yankee (RY)' will be displayed accordingly.



Vessels are requested to be mindful of the nature of the works, to be aware of vessels proceeding to and from the works, and of their wash when passing particularly during crane lifting operations.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
