

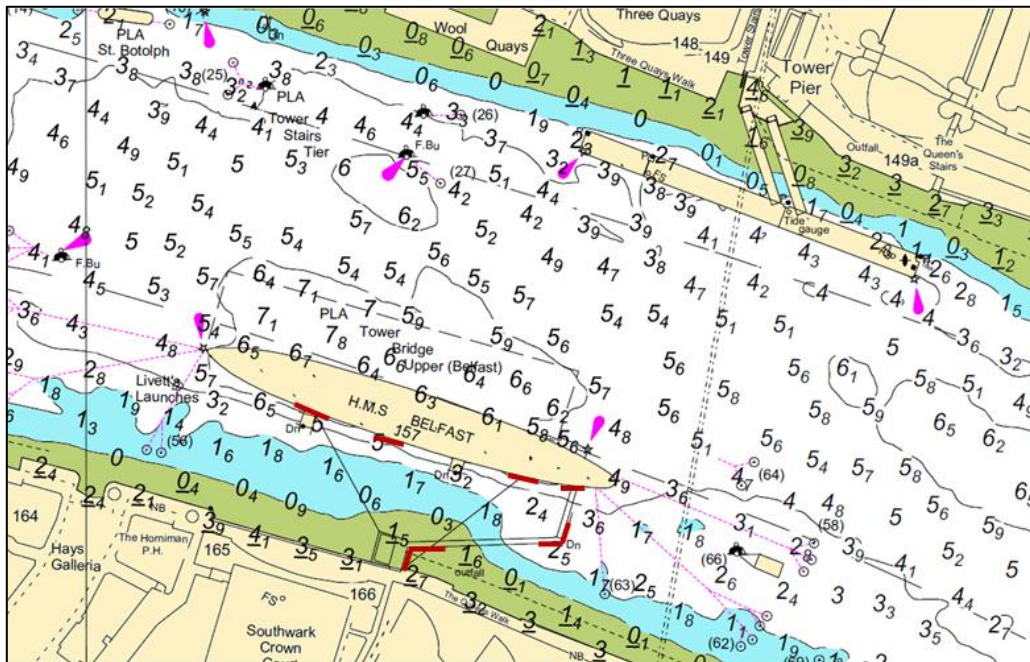
NOTICE TO MARINERS M56 of 2017

UPPER POOL HMS BELFAST

REPLACEMENT OF SEWAGE PUMPS

On or about the 17th July 2017, mariners are advised that contractors working on behalf of the Imperial War Museum will be replacing sewage pumps and pipework at HMS Belfast. These works will be undertaken from scaffolding positioned along the brow and hull of HMS Belfast, and are expected to take approximately 3 months. Working hours will be Monday to Friday from 06:00 to 18:00.

Safety boat “PASHA” will be on station throughout operations and will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 14. Persons in charge of vessels in the vicinity of these works are to navigate with particular care.
