

NOTICE TO MARINERS M58 of 2019

BOW CREEK CANNING TOWN ROAD BRIDGE ARCH CONTROL

Contractors working on behalf of Transport for London will be conducting maintenance works on the Canning Town Road Bridge. The contractors will be using the multicat MPV CHILI DOG in the centre arch on the following dates:

Arch	Date	Start Time	End Time	Navigational Information
Centre	Wednesday 4 th September 2019	05:00	17:00	Pre-notification of bridge transit required
Centre	Tuesday 10 th September 2019	05:00	17:00	Pre-notification of bridge transit required

To ensure the safe navigation of vessels under the Canning Town Road Bridge the works will be withdrawn from the arch when notice of vessel transit is received, to allow vessels to pass without any restrictions in air draft.

Vessels intending to navigate beneath the Canning Town Road Bridge during the prescribed times are to provide advanced notice of their ETA at the Canning Town Road Bridge to London VTS. This notice is to be provided either on entry into the Thames Barrier Control Zone, when departing any berth within the Thames Barrier Control Zone or when departing any berth in Bow Creek or when departing either Bow or Prescott Lock outward bound for the River Thames.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
