

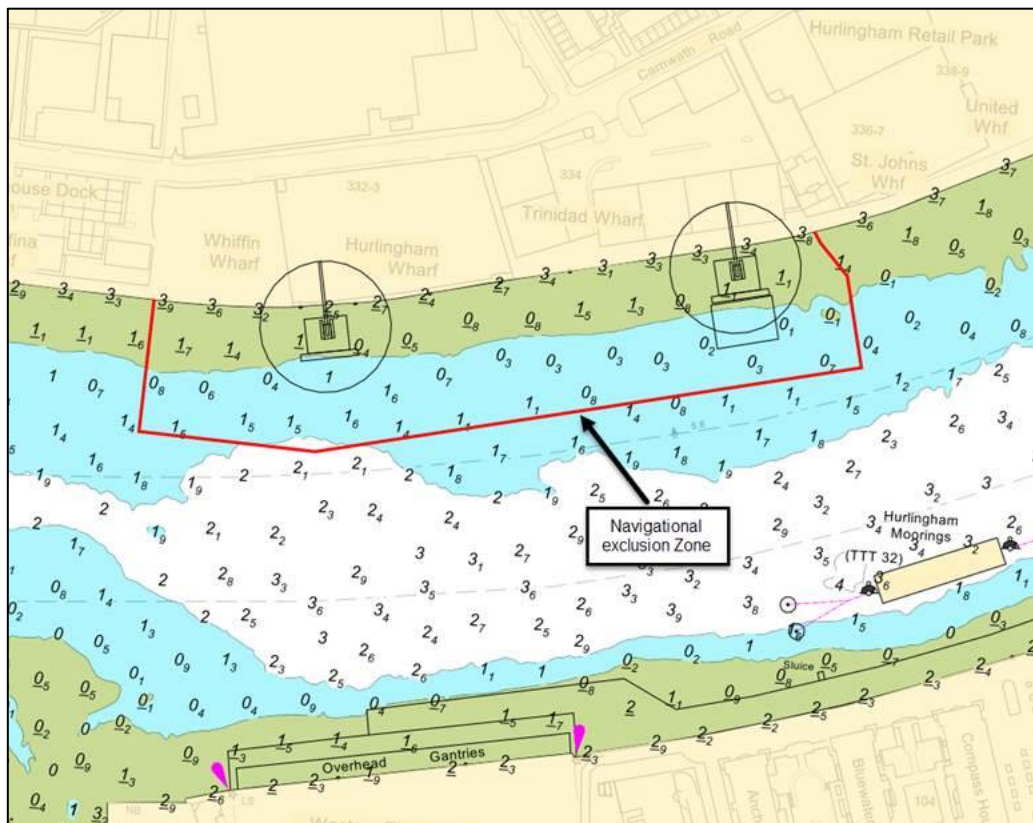
NOTICE TO MARINERS M59 of 2017

WANDSWORTH REACH

HURLINGHAM & TRINIDAD WHARVES CONSTRUCTION

Mariners are advised that on or about 25th July 2017, contractors working on the Tideway Tunnel Project will commence works which will involve installing reinforcing sheet piles and the construction a campshed at Hurlingham and Trinidad Wharves.

Please see the chartlet below depicting the location of the works.



The works which will include site investigation, river wall strengthening, sheet piling, dredging, installation of life saving chains and escape ladders together with the delivery of materials and equipment, will take place using a variety of barges including Jackup barges, crane barges, tugs and Multicat vessels and are expected to take approximately 7 months. The vessels involved will maintain a continuous listening watch on VHF channel 14. At times RY flags may be exhibited in conjunction with “proceed with caution / slow down requests” in VTS broadcasts.

No vessels other than those engaged in the works shall enter the navigation exclusion zone depicted by the red line on the chartlet.

Vessels are requested to be mindful of the nature of the works, their wash when passing the works and to pass at a safe distance.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
