# **BLACKFRIARS MONITOR INSTALLATION WORKS**

Mariners are advised that on or about 21<sup>st</sup> August 2017, contractors working on the Tideway Tunnel Project will commence installing monitors on the embankment wall monitor CPBS BULLDOG. The works are not expected to take more than two days.

Please see the chartlet below depicting the location of the installation works identified by the red oval.



The installation on the river wall will take place from the CPBS BULLDOG which will also have a safety boat close by. Installation works will take place when CPBS BULLDOG has tidal access to the embankment wall two hours either side of high water within the working hours of 1200 to 1900.

Vessels involved in the works will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 14.

Vessels are requested to be mindful of the nature of the works, their wash when passing the works and to pass at a safe distance.

London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014 as required by the works. International Code flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed only when this is in effect.
