

TEMPORARY BARGE MOORING

Mariners are advised that on or about 28th August 2017 contractors working on behalf of the Tideway Tunnel Project will lay a temporary barge mooring off Deptford Wharf.

The PLA vessel LONDON TITAN will lay a temporary barge mooring in a position south of the channel as indicated on the below chartlet.



The barge mooring will be laid as a tier marked by unlit Admiralty class buoys at each end and identified as Deptford Strand Barge Moorings. It is anticipated this tier will be in place for the duration of the Tideway Tunnel workings.

The installation works will be supported by DRIFTWOOD and other PLA craft. Vessels are requested to be mindful of the nature of the works, their wash when passing the works and to pass at a safe distance.

London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to "proceed with caution" or "proceed at slow speed", as described in Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014 as required by the works. International Code flags "Romeo Yankee" will be displayed when this is in effect.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
