

NOTICE TO MARINERS U12 of 2019

BRENTFORD REACH TO HORSE REACH (LOWER) **MASS PADDLE**

On Friday 21st June 2019, Active 360 is organising a mass paddle event 'Richmond Get On Board' from Kew Drawdock to River Lane Richmond, undertaking a litter pick from the exposed foreshore and overhanging trees.

Approximately 250 Stand Up Paddleboards (SUPs) and Kayak/Canoes will be navigating from Kew Bridge launching between 13:00 until 15:30.

Paddlers will reach Richmond Lock by approximately 17:00 and all paddlers will be off the river at Richmond by 18:15.

The paddlers will be in groups with a maximum of 12 paddlers per group, navigating on the Starboard side of the river.

In addition to the paddlers participating in this event there will be three support vessels in attendance.

40-50 paddlers with marshalls will depart Richmond at 19:00 and will return to Kew Bridge by 21:30.

Vessels navigating through this area, who are not involved in the event, are asked to navigate with caution and with due regard to their wash.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on **VHF Channel 14**.
