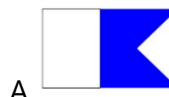
DIVING OPERATIONS

L15-24

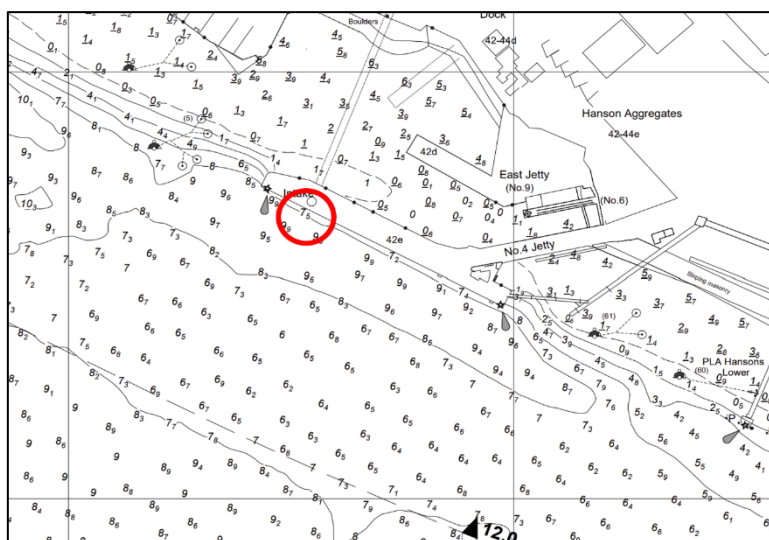
On or around **18th March 2024**, marine contractors working on behalf of City of London Corporation will commence diving operations at the upriver end of Hanson No. 4 Jetty in Halfway Reach. Diving operations will take place around the times of slack water.

Works are expected to last approximately 3 days. Diving Operations will take place from the Multi-Cat **"Emilia D"**, and works will include, but not be limited to, lifting operations and removal of grouting lines using underwater burning equipment.

Requests for vessels to 'proceed with caution' or 'pass at slow speed' will be made by London VTS on VHF Ch.14, in accordance with the Port of London Authority's [Port Information Guide](#), under 'London VTS', Section 4. When diving is taking place the dive platform will display International Code Flags 'Romeo Yankee (RY)', 'Alpha (A)' and a red flag in accordance with Byelaw 33 as appropriate:
