

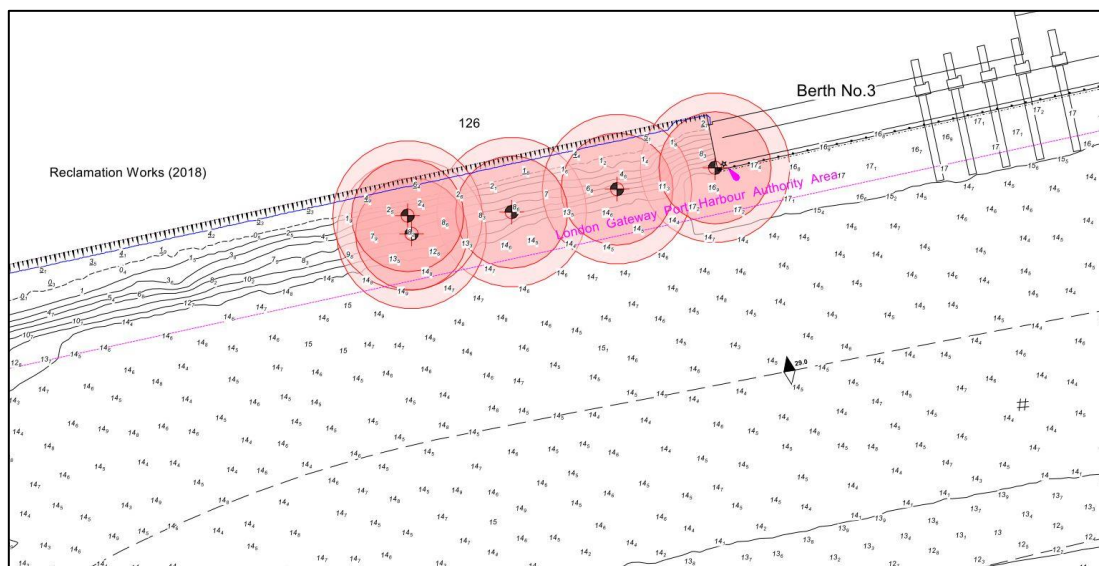

## BERTH 4 BOREHOLE SAMPLING

## DP WORLD LONDON GATEWAY

During the week commencing 23<sup>rd</sup> September and lasting for approximately 14 days, the jack-up barge (JUB) 'SKATE 3E' will be undertaking geotechnical investigations to inform the further design of the new berth No. 4 and quay extension.



During the works support vessels will be provided by Capital Pleasure Boats and the RIB 'OYSTER 3' will be utilised for the transfer of crew twice a day between the JUB and Canvey Island.

For the safety of those working on board the SKATE 3E a temporary 100m exclusion zone will be in place except in the following circumstances:

- Vessels arriving or departing Berth No. 3
- Vessels alongside Berth No. 3.
- Tugs assisting vessels on and off Berth No. 3

In the above circumstances, those vessels are permitted to be within 75m of the jack-up barge.

The repositioning of the JUB will be carried out in conjunction with London VTS to ensure there is no impact with vessels manoeuvring in the area. During the repositioning of SKATE 3E it will be restricted in its ability to manoeuvre and will display the lights, shapes and signal

flags in accordance with the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972 (as amended) Rule 27B.

All vessels will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 68.
