

NOTICE TO MARINERS M24 of 2021

KINGS REACH BLACKFRIARS BRIDGES ARCH CLOSURES & LOCAL TRAFFIC CONTROL

From 17th to 19th May 2021, contractors working on behalf of the City of London Corporation will be conducting electrical works on Blackfriars Road Bridge. In order to accommodate the works, arch closures of both Blackfriars Bridges will take place as follows:

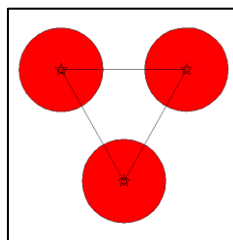
Start Date	End Date	Time	Arch	Navigational Information
17 th May	18 th May	22:00 – 05:00	4	Closed to Navigation and Local Traffic Control
18 th May	19 th May	22:00 – 05:00	3	Closed to Navigation and Local Traffic Control

The operation of the smart signal light for navigation of arch No.2 remains in place.

Local Traffic Control will be undertaken from a PLA Harbour Service Launch in the vicinity of Blackfriars Road Bridge for the duration of the closures. All vessels intending to navigate between Southwark Bridge and Waterloo Bridge are to call 'BLACKFRIARS CONTROL' on VHF Channel 14 as follows:

- Inbound at Southwark Bridge
- Outbound at Waterloo Bridge
- Prior to leaving a berth or mooring between Southwark Bridge and Waterloo Bridge

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012:
