

**NOTICE TO MARINERS M24 of 2022**  
**GREENWICH REACH TO LAMBETH REACH**  
**2022 THAMES HISTORIC BARGE DRIVING**

On Saturday 21st May 2022 the annual Thames Historic Barge Driving will be taking place. A total of nine Thames Rowing Barges will be rowed from Greenwich to Westminster.

The event is scheduled to start in the vicinity of Greenwich Pier at 11:00 and be completed at a finish line located at the lower end of St Thomas' Barge Roads by 15:30 after which the barges will be taken in tow back to their usual bases.

Barges involved in this event will have limited manoeuvrability and will be accompanied by a number of safety and support vessels as well as following passenger vessels. Passenger vessels following the event are to not position themselves so as to restrict the navigation of other vessels.

Masters of vessels navigating throughout these events should be aware of the limited manoeuvrability of the some of the vessels participating in them and should navigate at a safe speed paying particular attention to their wash.

**Local Traffic Control**

When necessary, local traffic control will be conducted from an attending Harbour Service Launch, call sign prefix "THAMES PATROL".

Further information regarding this event will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF channel 14.
