

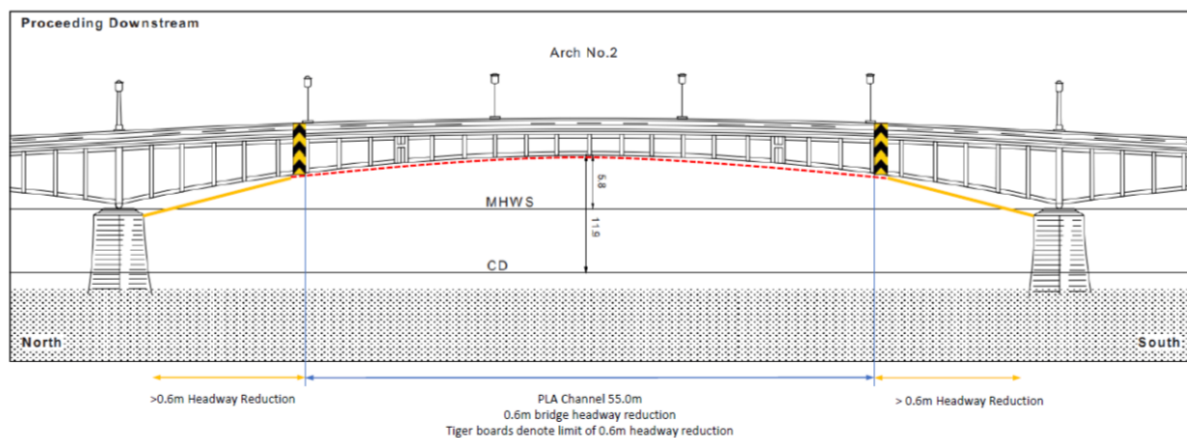
NOTICE TO MARINERS M45 of 2022

WANDSWORTH REACH WANDSWORTH BRIDGE SCAFFOLDING

This notice supplements [M54 of 2020](#) and supersedes [M26 of 2021](#) which is hereby cancelled.

Contractors will shortly complete Wandsworth Bridge refurbishment works and on or about the 1st of August will commence removing the scaffolding in number 2 arch. Scaffolding working hours will be 0730 to 1630 daily excluding weekends. Removal of the scaffolding is expected to take approximately 5 weeks. During scaffold removal abseilers will touch up paint on the contact points with the bridge structure. The last touch up painting will be in the yellow sections, after which the tiger stripe boards will be removed.

The SHELDEMONDE 1 will be moored in the vicinity of the piers within the yellow sections in the figure below. Scaffolding will be passed down to the SHELDEMONDE 1. The section between the striped tiger boards will have the headway reduced by 600mm until the scaffolding is removed. At all times vessels should only navigate between the two Tiger boards which will be attached to the bridge structure when the scaffolding is removed.



Safety Boat ALFIE will be on location during working hours and will advise the scaffolding contractors when vessels are approaching and again when clear of the work. Reporting vessels are to give 20 minutes notice to the safety boat prior to arrival at the bridge, in order that the scaffolders can vacate the scaffolding in the red section.

The attending Safety Boat will also maintain a watch on VHF Channel 14.
