Previously issued as NABSO 6 of 2020 which is hereby cancelled.

The PLA has been requested to issue the following **updated** message on behalf of the London Port Health Authority and regarding requirements to submit a Maritime Declaration of Health:

Please ensure that a Maritime Declaration of Health is completed and conveyed to the London Port Health Authority via porthealth@cityoflondon.gov.uk and porthealth.denton@cityoflondon.gov.uk for **ALL** vessels arriving into the port of London District **from outside UK waters** until further notice.

London Port Health Authority will inform the PLA which vessels have submitted the Maritime Declaration of Health. The PLA expect this declaration to have been submitted prior to the Pilot boarding the vessel, therefore it is advised the Agent/Master notify the PLA on submission. Failure to submit the Maritime Declaration of Health may result in your Pilot being cancelled or your vessel delayed.
