

HORSE REACH TO BARN ELMS REACH RICHMOND BRIDGE & PUTNEY BRIDGE - BRIDGE INSPECTION & ARCH CLOSURES

On or about Monday 4th December 2023 contractors will be conducting a principal inspection of Putney and Richmond Bridges. These works are expected to take place overnight and last 4 nights.

The works will be conducted from the barge, Scheldemond I, that will sequentially position itself in the bridge arches one by one. To accommodate these works, arches on Richmond and Putney Bridges will be closed to navigation as follows:

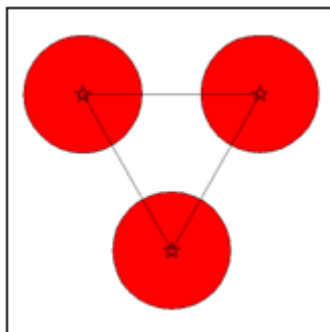


During the closure of Putney Bridge arches 2 and 3, Local Traffic Control will be undertaken from a PLA Harbour Service Launch in the vicinity of Putney Bridge. All power-driven vessels intending to navigate between Wandsworth Bridge and Hammersmith Bridge are to call '**PUTNEY CONTROL**' on VHF Channel 14 as follows:

- Inbound at Wandsworth Bridge
- Outbound at Hammersmith Bridge
- Prior to leaving a berth or mooring between Wandsworth Bridge and Hammersmith Bridge

Non power-driven vessels intending to transit Putney bridge should await instructions from the attending Harbour Service Launch.

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws (2012), as depicted - by three red discs (or by night, three red lights) in an equilateral triangle apex-down.



Where a Guard Boat is detailed the vessel **INDIGO LIMA** will be on and maintaining a listening watch on VHF Channel 14.

Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on VHF Channel 14.
