

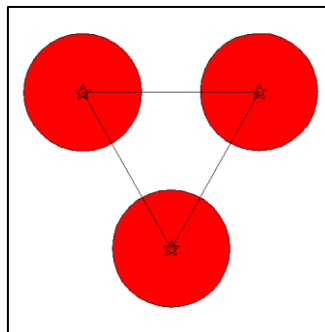
## NOTICE TO MARINERS      U5 of 2021

### MORTLAKE REACH KEW RAIL BRIDGE ARCH CLOSURES

Contractors working on behalf of Network Rail will be undertaking repairs to Kew Rail Bridge on or about **Monday 16<sup>th</sup> May 2022** for approximately one-week. In order to accommodate these works, No. 1 and 2 arches of Kew Rail Bridge will be closed to navigation during daylight hours.

Safety boat DEV-OCEAN will be on station maintaining a listening watch on VHF Channel 14.

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012:



Vessels are to be mindful of their wash and draw-off when passing the works. Requirements to proceed with caution or at slow speed will be made in accordance with the procedure set out in the Port of London Authority's [Port Information Guide](#), under 'London VTS', 'Section 4'.

Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on **VHF Channel 14**.
