Commencing on or about **Friday 7th November**, contractors on behalf of Transport for London will commence fender removal and installation at the North and South Woolwich Ferry terminals. Works will be conducted between the hours of 0700 and 1900, and last for approximately 3 days.

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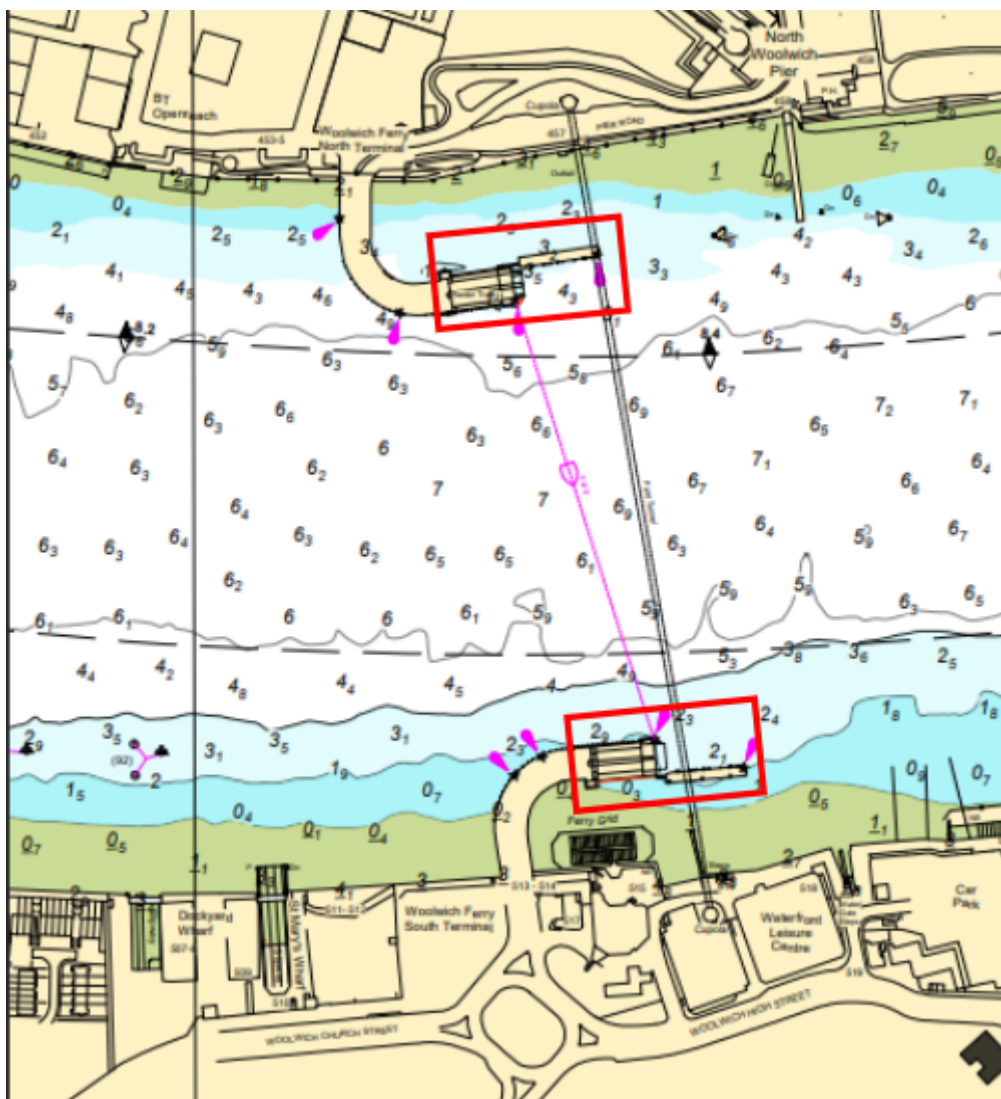
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NOTICE TO MARINERS
