



PLA NEWS: TIDEWAY CODE

- Latest edition of Tideway Code published in 2024
- In collaboration with Thames Regional Rowing Council and Paddle UK
- Updated guidelines for safe river usage
- Promoting good practice for all river users



PLA NEWS: RICHMOND LOCK & WEIR

- Commitment to 24/7 operations and maintaining water levels
- Maintenance plan and permanent Superintendent in place for long-term resilience
- New signage to improve river user safety to be installed


PLA NEWS: REVETMENT WORKS

- A 6-mile stretch of PLA-owned riverbanks and revetments run along the towpaths from Putney to Kew
- These sloping structures protect against flooding
- Regular revetment maintenance and management ensuring effectiveness and longevity



PLA NEWS: TREE MANAGEMENT WORKS

- Tree management works to keep the public and river users safe
- PLA and LBRuT developed the Wooded Towpath Plan 2022
- Tree-related incidents have since fallen from twice a month to 0
- In 2024, PLA spent £160,000 on management and improvement works






RIVER NEWS: RICHMOND TO KEW THAMES TOWPATH

- Towpath between Richmond Lock and Kew Gardens is closed
- Diversion route available and signage in place
- Emergency temporary measures carried out
- Permanent repair works start mid-April
- PLA collaborated with Richmond Council to facilitate river-based logistics




RIVER NEWS: THAMES WATER TEDDINGTON DIRECT RIVER ABSTRACTION SCHEME

- Environment Impact Assessment stage
- PLA raised issues ahead of EIA:
 - Tidal impact on navigation between Richmond and Hammersmith
 - Maintained level upstream of Richmond Lock & Weir
 - River regime, sedimentation, sediment transfer and salinity
 - Environment and aquatic ecology



RIVER NEWS: ENVIRONMENT AGENCY RIVER THAMES SCHEME

- Flood attenuation scheme on nontidal Thames
- Pre-consultation stage
- PLA raised issues:
 - Impact of scheme on fluvial flow levels over Teddington Lock
 - Combined impact of Teddington DRA and River Thames Scheme
- Flow levels entering the river at Teddington expected to remain neutral


FUNDING AWARDED THROUGH THAMES **ENVIRONMENT FUND**





PLA NEWS: THAMES ENVIRONMENT FUND

- £129,000 of funding awarded
- Projects in the upper district include:
 - Completed Fulham Reach Boat Club litter picks and education campaign
 - Current London Wildlife Trust's enhancement works on Isleworth Ait
 - Upcoming London Metropolitan University plastic pollution research
- PLA fund Thames21 volunteer litter clean-ups and water quality monitoring





PLA NEWS: AIR QUALITY

- Air quality monitored at riverside locations along the Thames
- An example of this is Richmond, where findings show positive results:
 - Nitrogen dioxide (NO2) levels are well under the national limit
 - Very low levels of particulate matter, in compliance with World Health Organisation Air Quality Guidance Levels


